Special Dance Events

16 Years and Over Cash Awards

- The following cash awards will be given in lieu of medals for Premier categories ages 16 years and over:
 - o 1st \$40, 2nd \$30, 3rd \$20, 4th \$15, 5th \$10, 6th \$5

Margo Naismith Memorial Sword Dance

- To qualify, dancers must place 1st or 2nd in the Sword Dance in their respective Premier age group and be under 16 years old.
- Qualifiers will dance a Sword (2&1).

House of Scotland Sword Dance

- To qualify, dancers must place 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in the Sword Dance in their respective Premier age group and be 16 years or older.
- Qualifiers will dance a <u>Sword (2&1)</u>.

The Sailors' Hornpipe Award

- To qualify, dancers must place 1st or 2nd in the Sailors' Hornpipe in their respective Premier age group.
- Qualifiers will dance a Hornpipe (4).

Special Pre-Premier Scholarships

 A "Judge's Honorable Mention" scholarship will be awarded to one Beginner (Sponsor: Macleod Pacific Region), one Novice (Sponsor: Macleod Pacific Region), and one Intermediate (Sponsor: SDSHG).

Dancing Rules

- 1. The competition is governed by RSOBHD and ScotDance USA rules.
- **2.** All dancers must be registered with ScotDance USA, or another registration body in order to dance. Registration Number MUST be on Entry Form and must be produced on the day of the event.
- 3. Age groups will be determined after entries are received.
- **4.** Organizer reserves the right to split or combine classes the day of the competition.
- 5. Dancers who are last to enter will be first to dance, and when applicable will fill in for a reel.
- 6. The organizer reserves the right to make changes to any information and times given in the entry form if necessary.
- 7. Communication by a dancer or parent of a dancer with the judge or piper is not allowed and is grounds for disgualification.
- 8. Pre-Premier category changes must be made by June 15, 2023.
- 9. Dancers not on hand when their class is called will forfeit entry on that event.
- 10. All winners must be in competition dress to accept awards.
- 11. All dance competitors and teachers are expected to comply with the RSOBHD & SDUSA Code of Ethics.
- 12. Entry fee includes dancer admission to the games. Ticket will be emailed prior to the event.
- 13. Competition numbers will be picked up at dancer registration on the day of competition.
- 14. Entries must be SUBMITTED by June 1, 2023. Late entries will be accepted with DOUBLE FEES.
- 15. Entry fees are as follows: Primary-\$30, Beginner-\$35, Novice-\$35, Intermediate-\$35, Premier-\$40
- **16.** An additional \$5 fee per dancer is charged for SDUSA West.
- **17.** Entry fees are non-refundable.
- **18.** Judge's decision is final. Any protest must be in writing, signed, and handed to the Dance Director by the end of the competition, accompanied by a fee of \$30.00 that would be refundable if the protest is sustained.
- **19.** Competitor numbers will be distributed at the event during registration.
